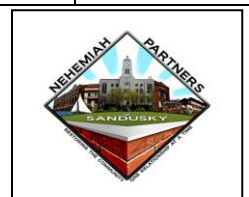

Tournament Rules And Information

5 on 5

- Ten man team roster
- All games will be played in two 20-minute halves, which will include a running clock that only stops for dead-balls in the last one minute of each half
- Five minute running clock for warm-ups (will begin immediately after previous game)
- Four minute running clock for halftime
- Overtime
 - 1st – Three minute running clock w/ clock stopping at all dead-balls under a minute
 - 2nd – Sudden Death (1st team scores, wins)
- Timeouts – No carryovers (i.e. regulation to overtime)
 - Regulation – Three (3) thirty second timeouts per team
 - 1st Overtime – One (1) thirty second timeout per team
 - 2nd Overtime – No timeouts
- Fouls
 - 5 personal fouls = disqualification from game
 - 7 team fouls = one and one bonus
 - 10 team fouls = two shot bonus
 - Other rules associated w/ OHSAA rules
- Technical Fouls
 - 1st = one and one bonus
 - 2nd = ejections from game w/ one and one bonus (?)
- Total of three game officials per game
- **NO CASH PRIZE TOURNAMENT**
- All others rules and regulation will be associated w/ OHSAA rules and reg.

Slam Dunk Competition

- Four dunkers
- 15 minute warm-up
- Three rounds – 2 dunks per dunker each round
- Scoring
 - Will take the average score of both dunks each round
- Tie Scores
 - Dunk-off (one dunk – highest scores wins... repeat if multiple ties)
- Pre-registration (7/11/2009)
 - Celebrity Judges (preferably community members)





Tournament Rules And Information

3 on 3

- Two day event (Saturday, July 11 – Sunday, July 12)
- Boys Division (5-6; 7-8; 9-10; 11-12)
 - **Note:** Participants will play in the division of the grade they will be entering in the fall of '09
- Girls Divisions (5-6; 7-8; 9-10; 11-12)
 - **Note:** Participants will play in the division of the grade they will be entering in the fall of '09
- Four person team roster
- All games will be played to 12 (win by two or first to 15)
 - 2-point shot = 1-point and 3-point shot = 2 points
- Games will be played on four portable hoops, which will be located in the parking lot north of the park
- At the end of each game, each team will be required to shake hands of the opposing team
 - If any team refuses to shake hands with opponent, two points will be awarded to the opposing team of their next game
- One court monitor per game, except for championship games (2 monitors)
- All fouls will be called by teams
 - Any disputed calls will be made final by court monitors
- All teams will have at least 10 minutes to arrive to court
 - There will be two announcements made for each game (Announcement Details: teams playing and court number)
 - Teams will forfeit game, if they fail to arrive to court within 10 minutes after the 1st announcement (10 minute running clock will begin after first announcement is made)
- One of the teams captain will shoot for ball first
- All teams will receive a t-shirt for participating in the tourney and will be advised to wear t-shirt during games. However, a coin will be flipped at the beginning of each game to determine which team will wear (a) the tourney t-shirts or (b) the netted jerseys or skin-up, if they don't want to wear netted jerseys.
- Technical free throw will be awarded to the opposing team, if any participant curses; commits a hard, intentional foul; initiates a fight; kicks or throws the ball; or makes any negative gestures or derogatory comments
- We will announce the champions and runner-ups of the 3 on 3 tournament and take pictures of team (location: preferably on stage - TBD), immediately after each championship game
